RECIPE FOR MONTH - Hangover Breakfast - Spinach &

Tomato Scramble

2 Large Eggs (or 1 egg, 2 egg whites)

½ teaspoon olive oil 2 cups baby spinach Wisk eggs in small bowl. Season with salt & pepper and set aside.

Heat olive oil in non-stick skillet-medium heat Add spinach & tomatoes cook tossing until wilted about 2 minutes.

½ cup chopped tomatoes

1 tablespoon grated parmesan Add eggs

Cook stirring occasionally until just set - about or goat cheese (optional) 1 minute - Stir in cheese (if using) Pinch salt/pepper

Why it works: Pass up the hearty, greasy breakfast for this scramble. Eggs Contain an amino acid, cysteine, that helps break down acetaldehyde, a toxin from alcohol metabolism.

Spinach and tomatoes are packed with antioxidants and potassium, an electrolyte. Serve with 100% whole wheat bread for extra carbohydrates to help with nausea and low blood sugar.
