CULINARY TIPS FOR MONTH - YOGURT

Easy Pizza Base - 2 ingredients

1½ cups Self Raising Flour

1 Cup Greek Yogurt

Mix together - knead (add more flour if too sticky)

Roll out to shape of pan - Add topping

NB: Make sure temperature is 260° c for cooking pizza in oven (use Greek yogurt – requires about 3 times as much milk to make as much yogurt – high protein)

Easy Yogurt Cake

Ingredients:

1 cup any flavour yogurt** (I find flavoured regular natural yogurt to be the best/room temperature) (250grams)

3 large eggs (room temperature)

½ cup vegetable oil (112 grams)

3/4 cup sugar (154.50 grams)

1½ cups all purpose flour (225 grams)

11/2 teaspoons baking powder

Powdered sugar Instructions:

Heat oven to 350 degrees (180° Celsius). Grease an 8 inch cake pan. In a medium bowl, using a hand mixer on medium speed, lightly beat eggs (approx. 30 seconds) add oil, sugar and yogurt, beat for 1 minute until smooth, add flour and baking powder and beat until well combined approx. another minute. Pour into greased cake pan and bake 35-40 minutes or until tested done (when toothpick or knife inserted into cake comes out clean). When cool, sprinkle with powdered sugar if desired.
